

Fifty-seven thousand five hundred (\$57,500.00) Dollars for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied to the cost of the purchase of a sanitary landfill compactor.

Section 2. That in order to secure said loan, the clerk-treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate a loan with a Commercial Bank in the amount of Fifty-seven thousand five hundred (\$57,500.00) Dollars payable in two (2) equal annual installments, which loan shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding six percent (6%) per annum, which interest shall be payable with the principal payments herein.

Section 3. As soon as can be done after the passage of this ordinance the clerk-treasurer shall give notice of the filing of the petition for and determination to borrow funds to pay for said landfill compactor. Said notice shall be published once each week for two (2) weeks in the Lebanon Reporter and the Jamestown Press, newspapers published in Boone County and of a general circulation in the City of Lebanon, and said notice shall be placed in three (3) public places in the City, as provided by IC 6-1.1-20-4 and IC 6-1.1-20-5. In the event a remonstrance shall be filed by the owners of taxable real estate under the provision of IC 6-1.1-20-4, then no further steps toward the borrowing of said funds shall be taken unless and until the Common Council has determined that said remonstrance is insufficient. In the event an objecting petition or petitions are filed by the taxpayers under provision of IC 6-1.1-20-5, then no further steps toward the borrowing of said funds shall be taken unless and until the State Board of Tax Commissioners shall issue its order approving the borrowing of said funds.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signing by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 79-23

ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, BEGINNING JANUARY 1980
