ORDINANCE NO. 79-27A

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED,  
" AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO LEBANON CATV, INC.,  
ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS QUALIFIED TO DO  
BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF INDIANA THE RIGHT  
TO ERECT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE IN, UNDER,  
OVER, ALONG, ACROSS AND UPON THE STREETS,  
LANES, AVENUES, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES,  
AND HIGHWAYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE  
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA AND SUBSEQUENT ADDITIONS  
THERETO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSMISSION AND  
DISTRIBUTION BY CABLE OF TELEVISION SIGNALS  
TO ENABLE SALE OF THEIR COMMUNITY TELEVISION  
ANTENNA SERVICE TO THE INHABITANTS OF SAID  
CITY AND OTHER PURPOSES FOR A PERIOD OF  
TWENTY (20) YEARS." PASSED BY THE COMMON  
COUNCIL AUGUST 7, 1967.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1

That the above entitled ordinance, being Ordinance No. 35 of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, passed by the Common Council August 7, 1967, be amended by striking therefrom the entire wording of Section IX as the same has been amended and inserting therein a new Section IX which shall read as follows:

SECTION IX: All existing rates and charges now in effect for subscribers to service from the company shall remain in effect until the same have been changed in accordance with the following procedure:

- (a) All proposed changes in the rates and charges to subscribers for basic Cable service, shall be filed in writing with the Clerk-Treasurer at least thirty (30) days in advance of the proposed effective date for such rate change. The Clerk-Treasurer shall submit such proposed new schedule of rates to the City Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting. If the City Council takes no action to set the proposed rate change for hearing or takes other action to delay such changes, said proposed rate changes may become effective upon the expiration of the thirty (30) day notice.
- (b) If the City Council determines said proposed rate should be set for public hearing, such changes will not become effective until the Council has taken action by means of a resolution.
- (c) This provision does not limit the right of the Company to pass along to the subscribers state and local sales tax or any specific copyright fees.
- (d) The Company shall at all times maintain on file with the Clerk-Treasurer a schedule setting forth all rates and charges to be made to subscribers for basic Cable service, including installation charges.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
