

Sec. 16-59. Snowmobile registration requirements.

All snowmobiles shall be registered with the Indiana Department of Natural Resources prior to operating within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon.

Sec. 16-60. Snowmobile insurance requirements.

All snowmobile owners operating snowmobiles within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon shall maintain public liability and property damage insurance on said vehicle.

Sec. 16-61. Authorized hours for snowmobile operation.

No snowmobile shall be operated within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. except in times of duly designated emergencies as declared by the Mayor pursuant to Article II, Chapter 8 of the City Code of Lebanon, Indiana.

Sec. 16-62. Snowmobile parking.

Snowmobiles may be parked only on designated routes and in city metered lots and parking spaces.

Sec. 16-63. Snowmobile traffic and safety requirements.

(a) All snowmobiles operated within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon shall be required to operate with their headlights on at all times.

(b) Snowmobile operators shall obey all traffic signs, signals, and traffic laws.

(c) Safety flags shall be flown from all snowmobiles operated within the limits of the City of Lebanon.

(d) Snowmobile operators and owners shall be required to comply with all Department of Natural Resources snowmobile regulations.

(e) It is recommended that snowmobile operators wear helmets while operating their vehicles.

Sec. 16-65. Penalties.

Any person found in violation of the terms of this ordinance shall be fined as provided in the general penalty provisions of the City Code.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 80-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 27 , SECTION 27-15, OF THE CITY CODE OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AND THE ZONE MAP, LEBANON, INDIANA - 1974 , AS IT PERTAINS TO SPECIFIC PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE ON WEST CAMP STREET, LEBANON, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: That pursuant to recommendation of the Lebanon Plan Commission, the zoning classification of the following described real estate, to-wit:

A part of the east half of the southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West of the Second Principal Meridian and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 1004.58 feet south of the northwest corner of the said half quarter section and proceed thence southerly with the half quarter section line for a distance of 317.48 feet to a point in the center line of Camp Street; thence easterly with the center line of Camp Street for a distance of 100.0 feet; thence northerly, parallel with the west line of the herein described tract, for a distance of 317.48 feet; thence westerly, parallel with the center line of Camp Street for a distance of 100.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.729 acres, more or less, but subject to legal highways, rights of way and easements.

Located in Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, known as 520 West Camp Street, Lebanon, Indiana, and

A part of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of said tract and run thence west 80.0 feet to a point of beginning, thence north 317.0 feet, thence west 116.02 feet, thence south 317.0 feet to the south line of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 25, thence east 116.02 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.844 acres, more or less; subject, however, to all public highways, legal rights of way and easements of record,

known as 620 West Camp Street, Lebanon, Indiana, is amended to read as follows:

Class C Residential

Section 2: That all provisions of the Zoning Code of Lebanon, Indiana, as the same pertain to Class C Residential property shall be in force and effect, as to the above described real estate, from and after the passage of the ordinance.
