ORDINANCE NO. 81-21

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
 AN ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS  
 BUREAU FOR THE CITY  
 OF LEBANON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:  
SECTION 1: There is hereby established an Ordinance Violations Bureau of the city of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION 2: The Ordinance Violations Bureau is hereby authorized to accept fines imposed for Violations of the terms of the City Code of Lebanon, Indiana, from those persons charged who wished to plead guilty to such charges, said Violations Bureau is further authorized to collect fees established for bicycle and moped license, copies of accident reports, theft reports and vandalism reports. Charges for copies of theft and vandalism reports shall be \$3.00 each.

SECTION 3: The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby designated as the Chief Clerk of the Ordinance Violations Bureau and shall keep the records of such bureau in such manner as she may direct. The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to appoint such deputy ordinance violation clerk as is necessary.

SECTION 4: In addition to the above duties, fees for the issuance of gun permits shall be collected by the Chief of Police only which are to be paid to the Ordinance Violations Bureau.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
