ORDINANCE NO. 82-9

ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND CONTROLLING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN TRAFFIC AREA OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA" PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 27TH DAY OF JULY, 1981

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1: That Section 7 of the above entitled ordinance be amended by adding thereto a new subsection entitled Subsection E, which shall read as follows:

Section 7, (E). In the event that a violator has complied with Subsection A of the above entitled penalty section and has no further violations within a six-month period, then said violation shall be purged from the record. In the event that the violator complies with Subsection A above and within the six-month period recieves a second or third ticket which would cause him to be charged under Subsection A or C and later after the second violation has no further violations within a 6 months period, then the charge against said violator shall be purged from the record.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
