

may be necessary or desirable to consummate the transaction, including the bonds authorized herein. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby expressly authorized to approve any modifications or additions to the documents constituting the Financing Agreement which take place after the date of this Ordinance with the review and advice of the City Attorney; it being the express understanding of this Common Council that said Financing Agreement is in substantially final form as of the date of this Ordinance. The approval of said modifications or additions shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution and attestation thereof and the affixing of the seal thereto or the imprinting of the seal thereon; provided, however, that no such modification or addition shall change the maximum principal amount of, interest rate on or term of the bonds as approved by the Common Council by this Ordinance without further consideration by the Common Council. The signatures of the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer on the bonds may be either manual or facsimile signatures. The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to arrange for delivery of such bonds to the Trustee named in the Trust Indenture, payment for the bonds will be made to the Trustee named in the Trust Indenture and after such payment the bonds will be delivered by the Trustee to the purchasers thereof. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer shall execute and the Clerk-Treasurer shall deliver the bonds to the Trustee within ninety days of the adoption of this ordinance. The bonds shall be dated as of August 1, 1982.

Section 6. The provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a contract binding between the City of Lebanon and the holder of the Economic Development Revenue Bonds (E-Z Rake, Inc. Project), and after the issuance of said bonds, this Ordinance shall not be repealed or amended in any respect which would adversely affect the rights of such holders so long as any of said bonds or the interest thereon remains unpaid.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 82-13

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 82-2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH PARKWOOD HEALTH CARE, INC. RELATING
TO THE FINANCING OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FACILITIES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES
OF LEBANON

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of January, 1982, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, did approve an Inducement Ordinance for the issuance of revenue bonds under the laws of the State of Indiana, including particularly I.C. Sections 36-7-12-1 to 36-7-12-37 as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the approval sought by Parkwood Health Care, Inc. had contemplated an issuance of economic development bonds in the principal amount estimated not to exceed \$400,000; and,

WHEREAS, Parkwood Health Care, Inc. now requests that the principal amount of the economic development revenue bonds be increased in an amount not to exceed \$475,000.

Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 82-2 be now amended to increase the approximate amount of bonds to \$475,000.

Section 2. That all other terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 82-2 remain the same.

Section 3. This Amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
