

of the bonds as approved by the Common Council by this Ordinance, or any other item required pursuant to I.C. 36-7-12-27(A)(1) through (a)(11), without further consideration by the Lebanon Economic Development Commission and the Common Council. The signatures of the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer on the bonds may be facsimile signatures. The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to arrange for delivery of such Bonds to the Trustee named in the Security Agreement and Indenture of Trust after payment for the Bonds has been made to the Trustee named in the Security Agreement and Indenture of Trust and the Bonds may then be delivered by the Trustee to the purchasers thereof. The Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer shall execute and the Clerk-Treasurer shall deliver the bonds within thirty (30) days of the adoption of this Ordinance. The bonds shall be dated the date of delivery thereof.

SECTION 6. The provisions of this Ordinance and the Security Agreement and Indenture of Trust securing the bonds shall constitute a contract binding between the City of Lebanon and the holder of the Economic Development Revenue Bonds, Series 1982 (Parkwood Health Care, Inc. Project), and after the issuance of said bonds, this Ordinance shall not be repealed or amended in any respect which would adversely affect the rights of such holders so long as any of said bonds or the interest thereon remains unpaid.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 82-15

ORDINANCE FOR ALLEY VACATION

WHEREAS, A Petition for Vacation of Alley has been filed by Petitioner, Robert D. Jenkins, Linda S. Jenkins, Larry B. Haag and Jo Jean Haag, with the Board of Public Works and Safety, City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board of Public Works and Safety that proof of publication of notice was given pursuant to statute, to-wit; that notice was published two (2) times on May 24, 1982 and June 1, 1982, in the Lebanon Reporter, a daily newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Evidence being heard, the Board of Public Works and Safety hereby finds that the alley hereinafter described is not being used as a public way, should be vacated and become part and parcel of the abutting property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF INDIANA:

That, the following described alley is hereby vacated as a public way:
