

178. "Utilities Service Board" - The administrative governing body of the public utilities of the City of Lebanon, Indiana. Herein also referred to as "The Board" or USB.
179. "Utilities Manager" - The administrative manager of the Utilities Service Board.
180. "Volatile Organic Matter" - The material in the sewage solids transformed to gases or vapors when heated at 550 degrees centigrade for 15 to 20 minutes.
181. "Waste" - Includes sanitary sewage and any and all other waste substances, liquid, solid, gaseous, or radioactive, associated with human habitation, or of human or animal origin, or from any producing, processing, manufacturing, or industrial operation of whatever nature, including such waste placed within containers or whatever nature prior to, and for purposes of disposal.
182. "Wastewater" - The water-carried waste from residences, business buildings, institutions, and industrial establishments, singular or in any combination, together with such ground, surface, and storm waters as may be present.
183. "Wastewater Constituents and Characteristics" - The individual chemical, physical, bacteriological, and radiological parameters, including volume, flow rate, and such other parameters that serve to define, classify, or measure the contents, quality, quantity, and strength of wastewater.
184. "Wastewater Treatment Plant" - Any arrangement of devices and structures used for treating "Wastewater".
185. "Watercourse" - A channel in which a flow of water occurs, either continuously or intermittently.
186. "Waters of the State" - Any water, surface or underground, within the boundaries of Indiana, except confined waters in sewers, tanks, etc.
187. The use of the word shall indicates a mandatory condition. The use of the word may indicates a discretionary condition.

SECTION 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

201. This Ordinance sets forth uniform requirements for Users of the Publically Owned Treatment Works (POTW), and enables the City to comply with all applicable State and Federal laws required by the Clean Water Act of 1977 and the General Pretreatment Regulations (40 CFR, Part 403).

The objectives of this Ordinance are:
