

Section 16-34 (c) Specific Parking Regulations -

- (1) On the north side of Essex Street between the west curb line of North Lebanon Street and the east curb line of Garfield Street.
 - (2) On the south side of East Busby Street from North East Street to Park Street.
 - (3) On the west side of South Meridian Street from the north curb line of West Ash Street north to the first alley.
 - (4) On the north side of Esplanade Street between North Lebanon Street and West Street and also on the south side of Esplanade Street for a distance of seventy-five (75) feet west from the west curb line of North Lebanon Street.
 - (5) On the south side of Fordice Street between East Street and Lebanon Street.
 - (6) On the south side of East Washington Street between Park Street and Grant Street.
 - (7) On the south side of West Main Street between the first alley west of West Street and the second alley west of West Street.
 - (8) On the north side of Busby Street from Lebanon Street to Meridian Street.
- (c) That Section 16-39 be amended by striking the present language therefrom and inserting the following language:

Section 16-39 Handicapped Parking -

It is unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any vehicle in a stall or space designated for physically handicapped persons, if stall or space is posted or marked in a prescribed way, unless the vehicle displays distinguishing license plates or place cards issued for handicapped persons, including disabled veterans, provided, however, that in the event a handicapped person is a passenger in a vehicle not so designated, then the driver of such vehicle shall be permitted to park in such space.

The designation of handicapped parking spaces shall be made by the Board of Public Works on city streets and by state authorities on state highways. These designations shall become part of this section by reference. Any peace officer is hereby authorized to remove any vehicle from a stall or space designated for physically handicapped persons if the vehicle is parked in violation of the above provisions.

SECTION 4: That Article II of Chapter 16 be amended by adding thereto a new division to read as follows:

Division 2. Traffic Flow

- SECTION 16-19 - TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP - A street map of the City of Lebanon has been prepared which indicates thereon the location of all traffic control devices within the city limits. Such map, titled Lebanon Traffic Control Map, is hereby adopted and made a part of this traffic code by reference. The original copy of this map shall be kept in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer.
- SECTION 16-20 - TRAFFIC CONTROLS - All vehicles approaching a traffic control device shall only proceed as directed by such traffic control device.
- SECTION 16-21 - ADDITIONS AND REMOVALS OF TRAFFIC DEVICES - Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Public Works and Safety, it becomes necessary to add or remove traffic control devices within the city, it shall by proper motion direct the desired action be taken. The traffic control map shall be corrected to reflect these changes.
- SECTION 16-22 - PREFERENTIAL STREETS - The following streets within the City of Lebanon are hereby designated as preferential streets:

Grant Street	Patterson Street
Park Street	Garfield Street
Indianapolis Avenue	Ransdell Road
East Street	Sam Ralston Road
Meridian Street	Noble Street
