NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF BUDGET ESTIMATES AND  
TAX RATES

Notice is hereby given the taxpayers of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that the Common Council of the City of Lebanon at their regular meeting place on the day of August 22, 1983 will conduct a public hearing on the budget. Following this meeting, the aforementioned Council will meet at their regular meeting place on the day of August 29, 1983 to adopt the following budget:

Taxpayers appearing shall have a right to be heard thereon. After the tax rates have been determined and presented to the County Auditor not later than two days prior to the second Monday in September, and the rate fixed by the County Tax Adjustment Board, or on their failure to so do, by the County Auditor, ten or more taxpayers feeling themselves aggrieved by such rates, may appeal to the State Board of Tax Commissioners for further hearing thereon by filing a petition with the County Auditor on or before the tenth day after publication by the County Auditor of tax rates charged, and State Board of Tax Commissioners will fix a date for hearing in this County.
