

ORDINANCE NO. 84-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 82-11
AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE
EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, JUDICIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE
ORGANIZATION OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA" PASSED
BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON JULY 12, 1982

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that Section 2 of Ordinance No. 82-11 be amended as follows:

Section 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 82-11 be amended by striking the language now contained therein and inserting in place thereof new language, and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 82-11 will read as follows:

Section 2: That new language be added to the City Code of Lebanon, Indiana, as provided for in Ordinance No. 82-11, which shall read as follows:

Section 2: EXECUTIVE BRANCH:

The executive branch under the direction of a Mayor shall be organized as follows:

- (A) The Mayor is the city executive and head of the executive branch. He or she shall faithfully perform the duties and responsibilities contained in I.C. 36-4-5 and other statutes of the State of Indiana.
- (B) There is hereby established a Board of Public Works and Safety within the executive branch. Such Board shall be the chief administrative body of the City and shall have control of the day-to-day operations of the following executive departments which are hereby established:
 - (1) Police Department.
 - (2) Fire Department.
 - (3) Street Department.
 - (4) Sanitation Department.
 - (5) Department of Parks and Recreation.
- (C) There is hereby established a Department of Law pursuant to I.C. 36-4-9-12. The City Attorney shall be head of the Department of Law pursuant to I.C. 36-4-9-11.
- (D) The members of the Board of Public Works and Safety are the Mayor and two voters of the City who shall be chosen by the Mayor and serve at his or her pleasure. The Chiefs of Police and Fire Departments are the heads of their respective departments. The heads of the Street Department and Sanitation Department are to be appointed by the Mayor and serve at the Mayor's pleasure pursuant to I.C. 36-4-9.
- (E) Subject to the appropriation power of the Common Council the foregoing Departments shall have the ability to hire such employees and purchase or contract for such materials or services, as the Board of Works and Safety or other governing board or commission deems necessary to perform their public functions.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

Section 4: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 82-11 shall remain in full force and effect.
