AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY POLICE TO SET A FEE FOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Lebanon police chief and patrolmen of the Lebanon City Police Department are, from time to time, called upon to make vehicle inspections pursuant to the vehicle registration laws set forth in Indiana Code 9-1-2-1(e), and

WHEREAS, studies conducted by the Lebanon City Police

WHEREAS, studies conducted by the Lebanon City Police
Department indicate that a fee would be proper and should be
imposed for such inspections in the amounts provided hereinbelow,
BE IT NOW, THEREFORE, ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1: There is hereby imposed a fee for any vehicle inspection made by the Lebanon city police chief or any patrolmen, or other peace officer of the Lebanon City Police Department pursuant to Indiana Code 9-1-2-1. The fee imposed by this section shall be payable by the person requesting such inspection, and it shall be paid at the time the inspection is performed. Upon the payment of such fee, the person making such inspection on behalf of the Lebanon City Police Department shall issue a receipt therefor.

Section 2: The amount of the fee established in Section 1 hereof shall be TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) if the inspection is made within the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon, and such fee shall be Three Dollars (\$3.00) if the inspection occurs outside of the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon. In addition, in the event that arrangements are made for an inspection other than at the police station located at the Lebanon Municipal Building, Lebanon, Indiana, and in the event that either the vehicle to be inspected or the person requesting said inspection is unavailable at the appointed time and place, then the fee shall nonetheless be payable whether or not the inspection is completed. An additional fee shall be payable at any subsequent time at which an inspection is actually conducted by a representative peace officer from the Lebanon City Police Department.

Section 3: Nothing herein shall be construed to require that the police chief, patrolman or other peace officer of the city of Lebanon travel to any location outside of the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon to make any such inspection, but the police chief or any authorized member of the Police Department acting in his place or absence, is authorized to permit a patrolman or other peace officer of the Lebanon City Police Department to so travel in the discretion, and at the direction, of the city police chief.

Section 4: All fees collected pursuant to this Ordinance shall be payable to the City of Lebanon, and shall be delivered forthwith upon their receipt to the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon and shall be deposited by the Clerk-Treasurer in the City of Lebanon Police Equipment Fund and shall be expended therefrom as other monies in said fund may be expended.
