

## ORDINANCE NO. 84-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL  
OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND  
APPOINTMENT OF DISPOSING AGENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

Section 1: The Street Department of the City of Lebanon and the Lebanon Fire Department have on hand certain personal property which belongs to the City and is considered unfit for the purpose for which it was intended and the same should be disposed of in that it has a total estimated value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) and is deemed to be unserviceable by the head of each respective Department and the Common Council. Said personal property consists of the following, to-wit: 35-foot radio tower presently located on the City parking lot directly adjacent to the Lebanon Fire Department; one each, leaf sucker-Donaldson, Wisconsin air cooled, Model No. VH4D, Serial No. 4410396; one each, sewer rooter, Clinton E-Z-Pull, Model No. 250, Serial No. 1781; one each, bush hog, Model No. 306, Serial No. 619842.

Section 2: The aforementioned personal property is qualified to be disposed of pursuant to I.C. 36-1-11-6(a)(2) and I.C. 36-1-11-6(c)(2).

Section 3: The head of the Street Department is hereby appointed as disposing agent for the property belonging to the Street Department and the Fire Chief is appointed as disposing agent for the radio tower and are directed to dispose of said property under the terms of I.C. 36-1-11-6. Since the estimated value of the personal property is less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), and the same consists of more than one (1) item, the disposing agents may sell the property at public or private sale or transfer the property without advertising. However, if the personal property is deemed worthless, it may be demolished or junked pursuant to said statute, provided that the successful bidder and/or purchaser of the surplus 35-foot radio tower on the parking lot adjacent to the Lebanon Municipal Building shall be responsible for the removal of same at his own expense.

Section 4: The disposing agents are hereby directed to make a report on their actions under this Ordinance upon completion of the sale or disposal of said property.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
