of Public Works and Safety. The Board shall have those powers and duties listed in IC 36-10-3-11, excepting therefrom the power of eminent domain which is specifically excluded in this adoption of IC 36-10-3.

SECTION VI

The Board shall prepare and submit an annual budget in the same manner as other departments of city government as prescribed by the State Board of Accounts. The Board may accept gifts, donations, and subsidies for park recreation purposes.

So much of those portions of IC 36-10-3-20, 21, and 22 pertaining to non-reverting capital funds and cumulative building funds, and the taxing powers, if any, given by Section 27 are specifically omitted and excepted from the City's adoption of IC 36-10-3 as the City has previously adopted Ordinance No. 84-21 allowing the receipting of proceeds and miscellaneous receipts into the special programs appropriation in the Parks Department and the same ordinance permits disbursements pursuant to said ordinance.

SECTION VII

The Board of Parks and Recreation shall continue their responsibility for operation and maintenance of Lebanon Memorial Park, James A. Hill Memorial Park, the Seashore Swimming Pool, Abner H. Longley Park and the recreational part of Memory Hall. The budget of Memory Hall shall remain a part of the budget of the Department of Public Parks and the leasing of space in Memory Hall shall remain subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

Rules and regulations previously adopted by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and the Board of Parks and Recreation under prior ordinances for the use of the parks of Lebanon, Indiana, or facilities charged to the responsibility of the Board of Parks and Recreation, shall remain in full force and effect, and are hereby specifically preserved in this ordinance and incorporated herein by reference.

All other ordinances, resolutions of parts thereof in conflict with the provisions and intent of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VIII

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and approval, according to the laws of the State of Indiana.
