

ORDINANCE #85-6

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LEBANON MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITY

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has heretofore on November 28, 1983, adopted Ordinance No. 83-25, which revised rates and charges for the distribution of electrical energy in said city and surrounding areas, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana, owns and operates the Municipal Electric Distribution System, known as the Lebanon Municipal Electric Utility, which has as its purpose the distribution of electrical energy in said city and surrounding areas, and;

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Utility Service Board, as the governing body of the Municipal Electric Utility, has determined that a new rate category should be designed and incorporated into the present schedule of rates to more accurately serve customers and the same to be established and used in conjunction with the other existing classes of customer rates established by said Municipal Electric Utility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. There shall be and there is hereby established for the use of and the service rendered by the Municipal Electric Utility a new rate category and charges therein, to be known as the rate SGP- Small General Power for the purposes of more accurately serving customers who would be subject to this new rate category.

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 83-25, adopted on November 28, 1983, entitled "An Ordinance to Readjust the Schedule of Rates and charges to be Collected by the City of Lebanon Municipal Electric Utility" be, and the same is hereby amended to include a new rate schedule to be known as SGP in the rate schedule attached to said ordinance as follows:

Municipal Electric Utility
Lebanon, Indiana

Rate SGP - Small General Power Service

Availability

Available to any customer for light and/or power purposes.

Character of Service

Alternating current, sixty Hertz, at any standard polyphase voltage supplied by Utility in the locality for which the service is requested.

Rate*

First 500 KWH per month	10.0¢ per KWH
Next 2000 KWH per month	8.5¢ per KWH
Next 2500 KWH per month	6.4¢ per KWH
Next 5000 KWH per month	5.5¢ per KWH
Over 10,000 KWH per month	5.0¢ per KWH

Monthly Minimum Charge

The Monthly Minimum Charge shall be calculated at the rate of \$1.25 per horsepower for all connected power load.

Such connected power load, as used in the determination of the Monthly Minimum Charge shall be the sum of:

- (a) The horsepower rating of all connected motors, and
- (b) The rated input capacity of all power equipment other than motors, each kilovolt-ampere of such input rating being considered as one horsepower of connected load. (Power load is defined as electricity used for any purpose other than lighting.

Metering Adjustment

If service is metered at a voltage greater than 480
