ORDINANCE #85-7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE
ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, has determined after a traffic study that a handicapped parking space is necessary on the west side of the Courthouse Square in downtown Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code, may regulate by ordinance the parking of vehicles and the traffic in this particular area of the city, and

WHEREAS, a necessity exists for the establishment of a handicapped parking space on the west side of the square in downtown Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Public Works and Safety and the Common Council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

Section 1. There is hereby established a handicapped parking space on the west
