

Ordinance 85-9 (cont.)

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board has reviewed the recommendations of the State Board of Health, and pursuant to Section 1301 of Ordinance 83-7, recommends to the Common Council that the limitations for discharge to the City's treatment system be amended as herein set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: At the recommendation of the Indiana State Board of Health, Division of Water Pollution and Control, and upon the recommendation of the Utility Service Board under Section 1301 of Ordinance 83-7, Section 25-111(b) of the Lebanon City Code, and Section 302 of Ordinance 79-5(a) and Ordinance 83-7 be amended to reflect new limitations for pollutants, copper and lead, and after said revisions the specific pollutant limitations for the City's pretreatment program shall read as follows:

Zinc	4.0 mg/l
Total Identifiable	
Chlorinated Hydrocarbons	0.0 mg/l
Phenolic Compounds	1.0 mg/l
PCB	0.0 mg/l

all pursuant to review of the ordinance provided by Section 1301 of Ordinance 83-7

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance 79-5(a) and Ordinance 83-7 shall remain in full force and effect including penalties for exceeding discharge limitations on pollutants set forth in said ordinances.

Section 3: The provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and any publication required by law.
