ORDINANCE NO. 86-6

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE I K PARTNERS SHOPPING CENTER
 HANDICAPPED, FIRE LANE, PARKING, PEDESTRAIN AND
 TRAFFIC FLOW ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and I K Partners, an agent for C. & W. Manhattan Associates, owners of I K Partners Shopping Center, entered a Contract for enforcement of shopping center traffic flow on or about the 9th day of July, 1984, and a general ordinance regulating said traffic flow was adopted by the Lebanon City Council in conjunction therewith, and

WHEREAS, the parties to that original contract have experienced positive management of traffic flow within said shopping center complex, commonly known as the K-Mart Shopping Plaza, and

WHEREAS, other owners and operators of shopping centers within the City of Lebanon have approached the Board of Public Works and Safety and the Mayor's office to have similar arrangements with the City for enforcement of violations and traffic flow management by the City of Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon and the Board of Public Works and Safety, deem it appropriate that the Ordinance No. 84-13 specifically pertaining to the I K Partners Shopping Center be amended to apply to all shopping centers within the city limits of Lebanon who express a desire to enter into a contractual arrangement for the management of traffic flow on shopping center facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that Ordinance No. 84-13 be amended as follows:

Section 1: That the title of Ordinance No. 84-13 shall hereinafter be referred to as SHOPPING CENTER, HANDICAPPED, FIRE LANE, PARKING, PEDESTRAIN AND TRAFFIC FLOW ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE.

Section 2: That Sections 1, 2, 3-d, and 5 of Ordinance No. 84-13 be amended by striking the language now contained therein and inserting in place thereof new language.
