ORDINANCE NO. 86-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS
PERSONAL PROPERTY AND APPOINTMENT OF DISPOSAL AGENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon fire Department and the Parks Department have on hand certain personal property which is deemed to be surplus and no longer fit for teh use for the respective department intended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA that:

Section 1: The Parks Department of the City of Lebanon and the Lebanon Fire Department ahve on hand certain personal property which belongs to the City and is considered unfit for teh purposes for which it was intended and the same should be disposed of in that it has a total estimated value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) and is deemed to be unserviceable by the heard of each respective department and the Common Council. Said personal property consists of the following, to-wit: fifteen (15) single metal-gramed beds presently located in the Fire Department quarters of teh Municipal Building, and approximately six hundred (600) pieces of mixed wooden and/or metal posting removed form Memorial Park as part of teh renovation program of the park.

Section 2; The aforementioned personal property is qualified to be disposed of pursuant to I.C. 36-1-11-6(a)(2) and I.C. 36-1-11-6(c)(2).
