

Section 1: An addition to Division 5, Rules and Regulations Applicable to All Employees, be designated (F) to read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 86-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THIE  
CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works and Safety for teh City of Lebanon, Indiana, has determined after a study that a change in the traffice regulations is necessary having heard recommendations from the police chief that stop signs be palced on Helena Drive at its intersection with Geri Drive, on an alleyway crossing East Chicago Street at the EastChicago extension and further that a reduction in speed limit from thirty (30) miles per hour to twenty (20) miles per hour be imposed on West Powell Street Between Jameson Street and Lafayette, Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for teh City of Lebanon, Indiana, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in these particular areas of teh city, and,

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for teh change of signage and speed limit regulations of these particular streets and ways in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.
