

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has notified the City of Lebanon of proposed modified flood elevation determinations affecting the flood insurance rate map (FIRM), flood boundary floodway map (FBFM), and flood boundary floodway map (FBFM), and flood insurance study (FIS) for the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has caused to be published notification of the proposed modifications of the base (100-year) flood elevations (BFEs) for the City of Lebanon, in the Lebanon Reporter, and that the appeal period for valid requests for changes in the said BFEs has elapsed, and

WHEREAS, as a condition of continued eligibility in the national flood insurance program (NFIP), the City of Lebanon is required to adopt the existing flood plain management measures in force in the community to reflect the data shown on the latest FIRM, FBFM, and FIS specifications on or before January 2, 1987.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1: A new section shall be added to the zoning code of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, pertaining to supplementation of the existing flood plain management measures and shall be known as Section 27-35.5, as follows:

Section 27-35.5. The basis for the delineations of the flood districts established in this section is the flood insurance study for the City of Lebanon dated May 3, 1982, which along with the accompanying flood boundary and floodway maps and and flood insurance rate maps and any subsequent revisions thereto, specifically the modified flood elevation determinations affecting the flood insurance rate map (FIRM), flood boundary floodway map (FBFM), and flood insurance study (FIS), for the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, FIRM map panels 1 and 2, numbered 180013-0001-C and 190013-0002-C, to become effective January 2, 1987, and any subsequent revisions thereto are hereby adopted by reference to be a part of this ordinance. Copies of these guidelines modifying flood elevation determinations as the same affect the FIRM, FBFM and FIS are on file in the Bulding Inspector's Office in the Municipal Building, City of Lebanon, Boone County, State of Indiana.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. any publication or public hearing thereof required by law
