

ORDINANCE NO. 88-4

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 18 OF THE
LEBANON CITY CODE PERTAINING TO PARKS AND RECREATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Parks and Recreation of the City of Lebanon, and the individuals responsible for maintenance at the park facilities, have engaged upon a turf management program to beautify and protect our municipal parks, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Parks and Recreation Department has experienced difficulty with individuals utilizing metal detectors within the public parks of the City of Lebanon and the Parks Department desires to maintain their turf in as good a condition as possible,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that a new section shall be added to Chapter 18 of the Lebanon City Code pertaining to Parks and Recreation as follows:

Section 1. That a new section be enrolled in the Lebanon City Code to be known as Section 18-4 by inserting new language at said section as follows:

The use of metal detectors and any digging device in connection therewith in the municipal parks of the City of Lebanon is expressly prohibited.. Any violation of this particular section shall be treated as a city ordinance violation punishable in accordance with the provisions outlined in Section 18-1(d).

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication required thereof by Indiana law.

ORDINANCE 88-5

AMENDMENT OF ZONING ORDINANCE

An ordinance amending the general Zoning Ordinance No. 75-5, 1975, by changing the classification of the zone district for certain parcels of land, more particularly described as follows:

TRACT I:

A part of Out Lot No. 20 of Rose, Harris and Longley's Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

From the northwest corner of the aforesaid Out Lot No. 20 proceed thence easterly, along the Out Lot line 33.00 feet; thence south 0degrees 06 minutes 22 seconds east (an assumed bearing) along the east line of South Lebanon Street, 7.5 feet to the point of beginning, said point of beginning being on the south right-of-way line of the C.C.C. & St. L. Railroad. From said point of beginning, proceed thence north 89 degrees 54 minutes 32 seconds east, with said railroad right of way, 13.50 feet; thence curve right, with a 355.98 foot radius curve, along said right of way 118.69 feet (the chord being south 80 degrees 32 minutes 21 seconds east 118.14 feet); thence south 0 degrees 06 minutes 22 seconds east 80.36 feet; thence south 89 degrees 53 minutes 38 seconds west 56.00 feet; thence south 0 degrees 06 minutes 22 seconds east 20.00 feet; thence south 89 degrees 53 minutes 38 seconds west 74.00 feet; thence north 0 degrees 06 minutes 22 seconds west, along the east right of way of South Lebanon Street 120.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.3151 acres more or less.
