

ORDINANCE NO. 88-7

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has recently undertaken a recycling program which affects various areas of the community; and

WHEREAS, persons, firms or corporations may have occasion to take or have taken recyclable items placed in front of a private residence which have been discarded, thrown away or set out for collection by the City's garbage collection contractor, or any other garbage collection service; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish proper receptacles for recyclable material to be utilized in conjunction with the normal weekly collection schedule of the City's garbage collection contractor and as part of the City's recycling program; and

WHEREAS, removal of designated recyclable materials by private citizens, firms or corporations, or scavengers, would inhibit the City's ability to move forward with a successful recycling program in the interest of the City's, county's and state's environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. It shall hereinafter be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to collect, obtain, possess or pick up or remove from any properly designated receptacle, any designated recyclable items placed for collection in front of a residence, in designated receptacles therefor, as part of the City of Lebanon's recycling program.

Section 2. DEFINITION: For purposes of this particular title, recyclable materials shall be defined by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon as consisting of glass, aluminum, and paper categories within a properly designated receptacle provided by the City's garbage collection contractor, at no expense to the City. The Common Council of the City of Lebanon may, from time to time, designate other classes of recyclable materials in addition to the three categories herein established.

Section 3. PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100).

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication required thereof by Indiana law.
