ORDINANCE NO. 88-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL CODE  
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the board of Public Works and safety and the common Council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, have determined after a study that a portion of the Lebanon City Code pertaining to traffic control needs to be amended, and having heard recommendations from the Police Chief regarding the matter, proposes to amend the City Code to provide for uniform speed limits within each of the subdivisions located within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. So much of Ordinance 83-8, Section 2, as the same pertains to the Enrolled Lebanon City Code of Section 16-16, sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) as they read now, to-wit:

- (a) The speed limits for motor vehicles within the City shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour within the following subdivisions and city parks:

Prairie Heights subdivision  
Abner Longley Park  
Lebanon Memorial Park

- (b) The speed limit for motorvehicles in the downtown business district shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.

shall be amended to read as follows:

- (a) The speed limits for motor vehicles within the City shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour within the following city parks:

Abner Longley Park  
Lebanon Memorial Park

- (b) The speed limit for motor vehicles in the downtown business district and the following subdivisions, additions, or residential areas, as hereinafter set forth, and those same areas approved subsequent to the adoption of this ordinance by the Lebanon City Plan Commission and Common Council, shall be twenty (20) miles per hour. Said subdivisions existing at the time of adoption of this ordinance for application herein consist of the following:
