

Section 3. A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 88-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THE  
CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety and Common Council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, have determined after a study that a change in the traffic regulations is necessary, having heard recommendations from Council members and concerned neighbors that a stop sign be placed at the intersection of Spencer Avenue (State Road 32 East) and East Noble Street for eastbound traffic on East Noble Street, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana and the Common Council, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code of the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the city, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the change of signage and traffic flow regulation on this particular street and intersection for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

WHEREAS, due to an ongoing neighborhood problem with heavy truck traffic which cuts across neighbors' yards and further attempts to avoid the stopping intersection located on Spencer Avenue traveling eastbound on Spencer Avenue to State Road 32, further efforts are necessary to attempt to alleviate heavy truck traffic and disregard for traffic regulations in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Spencer Avenue (State Road 32 East) and East Noble Street in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana, for eastbound traffic on East Noble Street.

Section 2. The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to the intersection of Spencer Avenue (State Road 32 East) and East Noble Street, all as located in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 3. A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the street and intersection designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
