

ORDINANCE NO. 89-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL CODE
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the board of Public Works and Safety and the Common Council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, have determined after a further study that an additional change in the traffic regulations is necessary in the vicinity of East Noble Street and Spencer Avenue, having heard further recommendations from Council members and concerned neighbors that a stop sign placed at the intersection of Spencer avenue and East Noble Street for eastbound traffic on East Noble Street, has failed to correct a significant truck traffic problem in the area, and

WHEREAS, after further study of this traffic problem, and upon recommendation of the Street Commissioner who has observed damage to storm sewer inlets in the area, curbing, and citizens' yard areas, the Board of Public works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, and the common Council thereof, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the City, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the change of signage and traffic flow regulation of this particular street for the public safety, and the preservation of municipal and private property within the City of Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing problem in this area with heavy truck traffic which cuts across neighbors' yards and further attempts to alleviate heavy truck traffic damaging municipal and private property, The board and Council deem that further efforts are necessary to attempt to alleviate heavy truck traffic and disregard for traffic regulations in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1. Heavy truck traffic on East Noble Street, between its intersection with Indianapolis Avenue (also known as business Route State road 52), and Spencer Avenue/State Road 32, in excess of 11,000 pounds, is hereby expressly prohibited by this ordinance. Said action is in addition to as top sign which has previously been placed at the intersection of Spencer Avenue (State Road 32 East) and East Noble Street in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana, for eastbound traffic on East Noble Street.

Section 2. The Board of Public works and safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to the municipal street, all as located within the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 3. A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the street and intersections designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100,00). Each offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
