

## ORDINANCE NO. 89-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL CODE  
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety and the common council for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, have determined after a detailed study that a portion of the Lebanon city Code pertaining to traffic control needs to be amended, and having heard recommendations from the police chief regarding the matter, and receiving a written traffic study concerning Chadwick Village subdivision, proposes to amend the city Code to provide for additional stop signs at tow different intersections within the Chadwick Village subdivision located within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, to-wit: the intersections of Sherri Lane and grant boulevard, and Barry drive and Grant boulevard, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the change of signage and traffic flow regulation on these particular streets and intersections for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, state of Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1. A three-way stop sign intersection shall be established at the intersection of Sherri Lane and grant Boulevard, requiring traffic westbound on Sherri Lane to stop at its intersection with Grant Boulevard, and further, requiring traffic traveling both north and south on Grant Boulevard, at its intersection with Sherri lane, to come to a stop before proceeding through said intersection.

Section 2. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Barry Drive and Grant Boulevard such that all traffic traversing westbound on Barry Drive shall be required to stop at its intersection with Grant Boulevard, only.

Section 3. The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to the intersection of Sherri Lane and Grant Boulevard and the intersection of Barry Drive and Grant Boulevard, all as are located in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 4. A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the streets and intersections designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
