

separate ordinance. This boundary ordinance incorporates all land area previously covered under Ordinances 76-15 and 80-27, in addition to newly annexed areas considered and approved by the Common Council since the passage of Ordinance 80-27.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable. If any provision of this ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
