

ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2C OF ORDINANCE 89-11,
AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES
OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA,
BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1990" PASSED BY THE COMMON
COUNCIL ON THE 24th DAY OF AUGUST, 1989

BE IT ORDAINED by the common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that Section 2C of the Ordinance 89-11 be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 2C of the Ordinance 89-11 be amended by striking the language now contained therein and inserting in place thereof new language, and Section 2C of Ordinance 89-90 will read as follows:

SECTION 3: The salary figures set forth hereinabove in Section 2C merely reclassify job descriptions of Parks Department employees and reallocates the same budgetary amounts for the Parks Department originally set forth in Ordinance 89-11. The total budgetary allocations for salaries of the Parks Department do not increase by virtue of the reclassification. This amendment to Ordinance 89-11 is undertaken at the recommendation of the Indiana State Board of Accounts despite the powers granted by Indiana Code 36-10 to the Parks department previously under Ordinance 86-19.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication required thereof by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 90-3

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF HOUSE ENROLLED
ACT NO. 1022, PASSED BY THE 1990 INDIANA LEGISLATURE
PERTAINING TO CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION IN A FLOODWAY
WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Harold and Linda Folden, residents of the City of Lebanon, attempted to remodel their home in 1988 and learned, to their chagrin, that the 1945 Indiana Flood Control Act would preclude them from pursuing their plans of remodeling, and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, pursuant to the Indiana Flood Control Act, and the floodway study performed in the City of Lebanon, precluded any type of remodeling or reconstruction on the Folden home, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the plight of the Folden family, several concerned citizens appeared in the Municipal Building in December of 1989 to participate in a town meeting wherein the
