

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE OF
THE CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, has determined after a study that a change in the traffic regulations is necessary, having heard recommendations from the Police Chief, and a state policeman living in the vicinity, that a stop sign be placed on the intersection of Brookside Drive, a newly opened subdivision street in the City of Lebanon, at its intersection with Morningside Drive, in that there currently exists no traffic signage or regulation at this intersection, and due to significant construction traffic and additional residential traffic which will occur as a result of construction, there is a need for some type of traffic regulation at this intersection, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the City, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the implementation of signage and traffic flow regulation on this particular street and intersection for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1: A stop sign shall be placed on the intersection of Brookside Drive at its intersection with Morningside Drive in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 2: The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to the intersection of Brookside Drive, a newly opened residential street at its intersection with Morningside Drive, all as located in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 3: A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the street and intersection designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, will amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
