

membership of the Lebanon Common Council; and the remaining member shall be selected from the general public and citizenry of the City of Lebanon who resides within the boundaries of the special taxing district established herein.

Section 5: The Board of Storm Water Management, after approval by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, in appropriate ordinance form, may:

- (a) Assess and collect user fees from all of the property of the storm water district for the operation and maintenance of the storm water system.
- (b) Issue and sell bonds of the district in the name of the municipality (City of Lebanon, Indiana) for the acquisition, construction, alteration, addition or extension of the storm water collection and disposal system or for the refunding of any bonds issued by the Board.
- (c) User fees shall include but not be limited to bonds, service rates, revenue bonds, or any other available funds.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, approval by the Mayor as provided by law, and any publication required thereof.

ORDINANCE NO. 90-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES 89-16, 80-27 and 76-15

PERTAINING TO THE DECLARATION AND DEFINITION OF THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CIYT OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, pursuant to Ordinance 761-15, 80-27 and 89-16, has previously defined the corporate boundaries of the City of Lebanon and declaring the annexation of all unannexed territory within said boundaries by virtue of passage of said ordinances, and

WHEREAS, since the passage and implementation of the above referenced ordinances, there have been additional territories annexed into the community which dictate that the City's boundary ordinance be redefined for purposes of public safety, provison of services, and in conformance with Indiana law, and

WHEREAS, the municipal boundaries of the community had not been redefined until the passage of Ordinances 80-27 and 89-16 encompassing specific annexations which have occurred since that time as a matter of ordinance, and pursuant to proper publication thereof, and the Common Council deems it appropriate that corrective revisions be made to the new boundary ordinance established under Ordinance 89-16 to completely define the boundaries and territories of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, where some omissions occurred unintentionally.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. The perimeter boundary of the City of Lebnaon, State of Indiana, is hereby established as follows: (Additions to this Ordinance shown by underlining.)

Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 19, Twonship 19 North, Range 1 East; thence South 2,643 feet along the east line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 1 East to the southeast corner of said quarter section; thence West 1,322 feet along the north line of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 1 East to the northwest corner of said half-quarter section; thence South to the northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast
