

Section 4. That the funds accumulated in the City of Lebanon Cumulative Capital Development Fund will be used for capital improvement as described in I.C. 36-8-14 (cumulative fire fighting building, equipment, police radio fund); I.C. 36-9-16-2 (cumulative vuilding funds); I.C. 36-9-16-3 (cumulative capital improvement fund); I.C. 36-9-16-5 (cumulative street fund); I.C. 36-9-17 (general improvement fund); I.C. 36-9-26 (cumulative building fund-sewers); and I.C. 36-9-27-100 (cumulative drainage fund), and any other purpose authorized by statute for capital improvements.

Section 5. Notwithstanding Section 4 above, funds accumulated in the City of Lebanon Cumulative Capital Developmetn Fund may be spent for purposes other than the purposes stated in Section 4, if the purpose is to protect the public health, welfare or safety in an emergency situation which demands immediate action. Money may be spent under the authority of this Section only after the Mayor of the City issues a declaration that the public health, welfare or safety is in immediate danger that requiries the expenditure of money in the fund.

Section 6. Effective Date of Fund and Tax. This fund takes effect upon approval of the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

Section 7. Certification to State Board of Tax Commissioners. Be it further ordained that proofs of publication and posting of notices of the public hearing held on the 23d day of July, 1990 and a certified copy of the Ordinance and such proposed plan for adoption of the City of Lebanon Municipal Cumulative Capital Developmetn Fund and its establishment for the City fo Lebanon, State of Indiana, be submitted to the State Board of Tax Commissioenrs of the State of Indiana, as provided by law.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.

ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN
