

to be applied on the construction of a building for the benefit of the citizens of the community of Lebanon, to-wit: a new Park bathhouse facility for the City's municipal swimming pool, together with the incidental expenses in connection therewith and on account of the borrowing of funds therefor, which Petition, and several counterparts, the Common Council finds to be in due form and properly verified by signers thereof and certified by the Auditor of Boone County as being signed by more than fifty (50) owners of taxable real estate in the City of Lebanon, Indiana; and that said Petition in all ways conforms to the requirements of the provisions of I.C. 6-1.1-20-3; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council now finds that the City of Lebanon has no funds available currently or provided for in the current budget and tax levy which may be applied for said projects, and that a public necessity exists for the making of the additional appropriation hereinafter set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1: That the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the proceeds of funds heretofore authorized to be borrowed by the City of Lebanon, the same which shall be applied on the construction of a building for the benefit of the citizens of the community of Lebanon, to-wit: a new Park bathhouse facility for the City's municipal swimming pool. The aforementioned monies shall be procured from a local financial institution at a simple interest rate of no more than 7.50%, a fixed rate. Interest shall be calculated on the basis of a 360-day year and paid for actual days elapsed. Approval of this rate and terms is subject to a commitment letter for this purpose made by the Mid State Bank with an expiration date of October 15, 1990.

The Mayor, the City Clerk, City Attorney, And all others required to participate in the documentation of the loan are hereby authorized to provide the financial institution from which the funds are procured copies of the necessary request for appropriation, as signed by the Board of Public Works and Safety, a copy of this ordinance, a properly prepared borrowing resolution, and such other documents as may be required to conform to the requirements of Indiana law.

The loan to the City of Lebanon shall be evidenced by a promissory note not to exceed the Principal amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) and in a form which is satisfactory to both the City and the Financial institution. Payment shall be made upon the principal balance in six(6) equal principal payments of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) each plus interest beginning on or about July 1, 1991, and expiring on January 1, 1994.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor, and any publication and posting thereof as required by Indiana Law.
