

Lebanon Redevelopment Commission.

3. Pursuant to the Act all of the territory within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lebanon will be a taxing district to be known as the Redevelopment District of the City of Lebanon for the purpose of levying and collecting special benefit taxes for redevelopment purposes as provided in the Act. The Common Council finds and determines that all of the taxable property within this special taxing district will be considered to be benefited by the redevelopment projects and economic development projects carried out under the Act to the extent of the special taxes levied under the Act.

4. The Common Council hereby appoints James Lewis and Ann Graham as members of the Lebanon Redevelopment Commission to be appointed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon with terms expiring on January 1, 1992. The remaining three(3) members shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon as the municipal executive thereof.

5. All other ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions and the intent of this Ordinance as contained in the Lebanon City Code are hereby repealed.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage and any publication required thereof by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 90-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ESTABLISHED COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, The Boone County Commissioners and the office of the Clerk of Boone County, Indiana, have caused to be filed with the State Election Board a revision of certain precincts and their boundary lines within the City of Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, said revision of precincts of boundary lines affects the stated Councilmanic Districts as established under Ordinance No. 82-23, as passed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, on or about October 25,1982, and Ordinance No. 86-4 passed by the Common Council on or about May 12,1986, and,

WHEREAS, to incorporate the the changes in the number of precincts and precinct boundaries in the City of Lebanon, the Common Council does propose to amend its present Councilmanic District Ordinance to conform to the newly adopted precinct boundaries adopted and approved for the City of Lebanon, and to prevent substantial confusion at the polls in the next general election for the City officials in November, 1991, and to prevent substantial expense being billed back to the City of Lebanon by the County Clerk for extra voting machines and personnel required to accommodate the existing City legislative districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1. The City of Lebanon, Indiana, has been and shall remain divided into five (5) Councilmanic Districts.

Section 2. Said districts shall be numbered one(1) through five (5), shall include certain city precincts with the descriptions of each of the precincts counting as the boundaries for said Councilmanic Districts as hereinafter set forth:

(A) COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT NO. 1
