AMENDMENT TO
ORDINANCE NO. 1991- SEW-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES
COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, FROM THE OWNERS
OF PROPERTY SERVED BY THE SEWAGE WORKS OF SAID CITY,

Section 13. The rates and charges as herein set forth shall become effective on the first full billing period occurring after the adoption of this ordinance with the exception of the \$750 tap-on fee set forth in section 3(a) III which shall become effective January 1, 1992. All funds obtained upon the inception of the new tap-on fee shall be utilized for sewage collection and improvement projects designated by the City of Lebanon/Utility Service Board or owners of real estate, and, provide owners of real estate such protection as is afforded by the provisions of statutes of the State of Indiana for sanitary sewage facilities constructed by said owners of real estate under contract with the City. Funds collected from the \$750 tap-on fee shall be placed in a separate account to be designated the Interceptor Improvement and Betterment Fund. Projects which shall be funded from said Interceptor Improvement and Betterment Fund shall include new truck and interceptor sewers, improvements to existing trunk or interceptor sewers, and such sewage collection improvement projects as are determined by the Board of Public Works and Safety or Utility Service Board for the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN
