ORDINANCE NO. 91-10
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THE
CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA STOP SIGN: PARK/WASHINGTON STREETS

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, has determined after a traffic study that a change in the traffic regulations is necessary within the community, having heard recommendations from the Police Chief, from nearby school authorities, and from interested citizens appearing before the Common Council, and for the public safety, it is determined that stop signage is necessary at the intersection of Park Street and Washington Street within the boundaries of the City of Lebanon, Indiana. There currently exists no traffic signage or regulation at this particular intersection other than painted yellow curbs which have been deemed insufficient by the Board of Works, Police Department, and traffic surveys conducted by private citizens, and it has been determined that due to the significant amount of traffic flow which occurs on this particular street and intersection in the morning and evening hours associated with to and from work traffic that there is a definite need for some type of traffic regulation at this particular intersection, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the city, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the implementation of signage and traffic flow regulation on these particular streets and this particular intersection for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1: An elevated stop sign, proposed to be suspended above the intersection itself to provide more visibility, shall be placed at the intersection of Park and Washington Streets requiring all traffic from all directions to come to a 4-way stop at this particular intersection before proceeding into the flow of traffic further on either east or westbound Washington Street or north or southbound Park Street. An elevated blinking stop signal shall be acquired by the City and installed at the intersection of Park and Washington Streets to control traffic flow and visibility at this particular intersection. In addition, additional temporary signage, as may be deemed required by the Board of Public Works and the City of Lebanon, may be implemented to regulate traffic stoppage at this particular intersection and to acquaint the general public with the necessity to come to a full and complete stop at this particular intersection before proceeding on in traffic flow, all as shall be located within the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 2: The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage as indicated above to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to the intersection of Park and Washington Streets as located in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 3: A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the street and intersection designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this Ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense and the traffic map of the City of Lebanon calling for a 4-way stop sign placement shall be amended accordingly.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
