

ORDINANCE NO. 92- 3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THE  
CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and the Common Council, have determined after a traffic survey conducted by the Lebanon City Police Department that a change in the traffic regulations is necessary in the City of Lebanon at the intersection of Howard Street and Park Street, Howard Street and East Street, Howard Street and Meridian Street, and Howard Street and North Lebanon Street, to provide for traffic signage designating that traffic is required to make a complete stop, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and the Common Council, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the city, subject to approval of the Indiana Department of Highways for the signage pertaining to North Lebanon Street which is also a portion of the State Highway system, being State Road 39 North, and having obtained approval of the signage proposed herein, and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the implementation of signage and traffic flow regulation on this particular street and intersections for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that:

Section 1: Stop signs shall be installed at the intersection of Howard Street and Park Street, Howard Street and East Street, Howard Street and Meridian Street, and Howard Street and North Lebanon Street.

Section 2: The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the


general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to these intersections so named, all as located in the City of Lebanon, State of Indiana.

Section 3: A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the streets and intersections designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation, and upon a finding of violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Each day of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.


Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.


