

Ordinance No. 93-2

An Ordinance Naming a City Street

WHEREAS, it is necessary for planning and development and for public convenience that a street commonly referred to as Westgate Boulevard to be officially named as such; and

WHEREAS, said street is located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the Area Plan Commission for the City of Lebanon has requested that said street be formally named; and

WHEREAS, said street has historically been referred to by its ordained name but no ordinance has heretofore been legally passed so naming said street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON that:

1. The city street located north of State Road 32 and located immediately west of the Kentucky Fried Chicken and Ponderosa Restaurant complex shall be named Westgate Boulevard from and after the effective date of this Ordinance.

2. The Director of Planning and Development shall so reflect the adopted name of said street on all official city maps and planning and zoning documents as required by law.

3. Notice of the street name shall be published one (1) time in the Lebanon Reporter newspaper by publication of this Ordinance in its entirety.

All of which is ordained this 25th day of January, 1993.
