

ORDINANCE 93-10

**ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA
BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1994**

Section 1: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

Section 2: That the maximum salaries including longevity of the following job classifications of the City of Lebanon, beginning January 1, 1994 be as follows:
