

Ordinance No. 94- 9

An Ordinance Repealing the Provisions of
Penal Ordinance No. 23-71 and
Modifying the Traffic Code Accordingly


WHEREAS, Penal Ordinance No. 23-71, passed November 22,
1971, provided for traffic to come to a complete stop on South
Grant Street at the location of the Commercial Filters driveway,
whenever a flasher was operating atop a standard stop sign;
and,

WHEREAS, it is not now necessary to so regulate traffic in
this area; and,


WHEREAS, the stop signs are now removed by Order of the
Board of Works with the agreement of Commercial Filters.

CITY OF LEBANON that:


1. That the provisions of Penal Ordinance No. 23-71 are

July, 1994.






