

Ordinance No. 95- 8

An Ordinance Amending the Utility Code
of the City of Lebanon
State of Indiana

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Utility Service Board has approved standards for discharge of wastewater in the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the standards so adopted are in conformity with the Federal Categorical Pretreatment Standards for particular industry subcategories; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Standards, if more stringent than limitations imposed under this Ordinance, should supersede the limitations imposed herein; and

WHEREAS, Section 25-111 of the Lebanon City Code contains limitations on wastewater strength and concentration of certain pollutants; and

WHEREAS, specific pollutant limitations have been adopted by the Lebanon Utility Service Board and said limitations should be made a part of the Lebanon City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEBANON UTILITY SERVICE BOARD AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON that:

- 1. Section 25-111 of the Lebanon City Code is amended to include specific pollutant limitations as follows:

Specific Pollutant Limitations. No person shall discharge wastewater containing in excess of:

Federal Categorical Pretreatment Standards. Upon the promulgation of the Federal Categorical Pretreatment Standards for a particular industrial subcategory, the Federal Standard, if more stringent than limitations imposed under this Ordinance for sources in that subcategory, shall immediately supersede the limitations imposed under this Ordinance. The Superintendent shall notify all affected Users of the applicable reporting requirements under 40 CFR, Section 403.12.

Modification of Federal Categorical Pretreatment Standards. Where the POTW achieves consistent removal of pollutants limited by Federal Pretreatment Standards, the POTW may apply to the Approval Authority for modification of specific limits in the Federal Pretreatment Standards. "Consistent Removal" shall mean the average of the lowest fifty percent (50%) of the removals measured according to Paragraph (d) (2) of Section 403.7, 40 CFR 403 and shall mean a reduction in amount of a pollutant in the POTW's effluent or alternation of the nature of a pollutant during treatment at the POTW when measured according to the procedures set forth in Section 403.7 of (Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 403) - "General Pretreatment Regulations for Existing and New Sources of Pollution" promulgated pursuant to the Act. The POTW may then modify pollutant discharge limits in the Federal Pretreatment Standards if the requirements contained in 40 CFR, Part 403, Section 403.7, are fulfilled and prior approval from the Approval Authority is obtained.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication which may be required of the same by law.
