

Ordinance No. 95- 12

An Ordinance Establishing and Naming
a City Street

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon has by resolution recommended naming the city street connecting Birchwood Drive and Thompson Street on the City's southwest side; and

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction over the naming of city streets and accepting the dedication thereof where applicable; and

WHEREAS, the connecting street described herein has not heretofore been named nor dedicated; and,

WHEREAS, the street shall serve as a border street to the City's Abner Longley Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON that:

Section 1. The street connecting Birchwood Drive and Thompson Street on the west side of Abner Longley Park is hereby established as Longley Drive.

Section 2. The Board of Public Works and Safety shall order appropriate signage to show the named street and further establish the speed limit and any other traffic limitations thereon.

Section 3. The official maps of the City of Lebanon shall be updated to reflect the establishment of Longley Drive. Future recordings of the plat of the City of Lebanon should likewise reflect this action.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and any publication required by law.
