

Ordinance No. 96- 9

An Ordinance Amending the Building Code of the
City of Lebanon, Indiana
With Respect to Multi-family Dwellings
and Gas and Electric Meter Identification

WHEREAS, as a matter of public safety, the Lebanon Utility Service Board and the Board of Public Works and Safety have determined that in multi-family dwelling projects both residential gas and electric meters should be identified with respect to the residence each serves; and

WHEREAS, such identification is critically necessary in the case of a fire, utility emergency, natural disaster or accident; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has determined that Chapter 7 of the Lebanon City Code should be supplemented by the terms of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. In all multi-family dwelling projects the owner/developer/builder shall identify electric and gas meters by apartment, condominium or building number by visible permanent identification markings not less than two (2) inches in height and attached directly to the outside meter(s) or electrical box.

2. The identification shall be done at the time gas or electric service is installed at the residence.

3. The office of the Building Inspector shall be charged with the enforcement of this Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and any publication required by law.
