

Ordinance No. 97-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE  
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana and the Common Council have determined after traffic survey conducted by the Lebanon City Police Department that a change in the traffic regulations is necessary in the City of Lebanon at the intersections of Countryside Drive and Elm Swamp Road and Nottingham Lane at Countryside Drive, to provide for traffic signage designating that traffic is required to make a complete stop; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and the Common Council, pursuant to all applicable sections of the Indiana Code and the Lebanon City Code, may regulate by ordinance the traffic of motor vehicles in this particular area of the City; and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists for the implementation of signage and traffic flow regulation on these particular streets and these intersections for the public safety in the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Public Works and Safety and the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, that:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be installed at the intersections of Countryside Drive and Elm Swamp Road and Nottingham Lane and Countryside Drive.

Section 2. The Board of Public Works and Safety is directed to cause the installation of appropriate signage to inform the general public of the change of traffic regulations pertaining to these intersections so named, all as located in the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

Section 3. The stop signs shall be located on Countryside Drive so as to cause Countryside Drive traffic to stop at the intersection of Elm Swamp Road and a stop sign shall be located on Nottingham Lane so as to cause Nottingham Lane traffic to stop at the intersection of Countryside Drive.

Section 4. A violation of the provisions of the City Code pertaining to these traffic regulations on the streets and intersections designated herein, occurring after the adoption of this Ordinance, shall amount to a City of Lebanon ordinance violation and upon a finding of the violation of such ordinance, the violator shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00). Each time of the offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in any publication which may be required by law.
