

Ordinance No. 99- 8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LATE CHARGE
 ASSESSED FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED
 BY THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE
 CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Utility Service Board has determined that it is in the interest of the Company as well as the ratepayers to modify the late charge assessed on all bills for water service; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that a flat percentage rate will serve the purpose of assessing an adequate late charge as well as be easily determinable; and

WHEREAS, the use of a flat rate three percent (3%) will constitute a savings for ratepayers.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 78-24 is hereby modified to read as follows:


All bills for water service not paid within ten (10) days from the due date thereof shall, as stated in such bills, be subject to a collection of deferred payment charge of three percent (3%) on the outstanding unpaid balance.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and any publication required by law.
