ORDINANCE NO. 99-16

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council has been approached by the First Church of the Nazarene, Tsung W. and Shu C. Ran, and James T. and Paulette Riley, by and through their legal representative, who have petitioned for the vacation of an unplatted city street located in Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing on the northwest corner of Lot No. 210 in the Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence south 362.97 feet to the southwest corner of Lot No. 218 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence west to the southeast corner of Lot No. 233 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence north 362.97 feet to the northeast corner of Lot No. 241 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence east 50 feet to the point of beginning.

and

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council has conducted a public hearing on said proposed vacation and has deemed it appropriate that said street be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That a certain public street located in the City of Lebanon, County of Boone, State of Indiana, hereinafter described as follows:

Commencing on the northwest corner of Lot No. 210 in the Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence south 362.97 feet to the southwest corner of Lot No. 218 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence west to the southeast corner of Lot No. 233 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence north 362.97 feet to the northeast corner of Lot No. 241 in Fairview Addition to the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana; thence east 50 feet to the point of beginning.


