

ORDINANCE NO. 10- 14

**AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING SOLICITATION ON PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS
IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Indiana statutes provide for a municipality to regulate traffic on public roads and streets within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Indiana statutes provide for a municipality to regulate pedestrian traffic and solicitation on public roads and streets within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana (“the City”) has jurisdiction for the enforcement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on public roads and streets within the corporate boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, officials of the City of Lebanon and its residents have noted increased activity of solicitation by pedestrians on public roads and streets, which has a negative impact on the safety of the community, and impedes the orderly flow of vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, The Common Council for the City of Lebanon believe it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Lebanon to amend the Lebanon City Code to provide for certain restrictions on solicitation by pedestrians on public roads and streets to help protect the public health safety and welfare of the its citizens and the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby finds it is in the public interest to amend the Lebanon City Code such that solicitation by pedestrians is prohibited on State Road 39 and State Road 32 within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lebanon, and the solicitation by pedestrians on any other public street or road is also prohibited.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana that:

In the interest of public safety and to further the orderly flow of vehicular traffic within the City of Lebanon, The Lebanon City Code is hereby amended to provide:

1. Solicitation by pedestrians is prohibited on State Road 39 and State Road 32 within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lebanon; and
2. Solicitation by pedestrians on any public street or road within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lebanon is prohibited.
