

ORDINANCE NO. 10-18

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON WEST MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Indiana statutes provide for a municipality to regulate motor vehicle use and parking within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana (“the City”) has jurisdiction over West Main Street, a public thoroughfare and road within the corporate boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, The Unified Development Ordinance and Lebanon City Code do not currently address the parking of motor vehicles in front of the U. S. Post Office located at 304 West Main Street (“Post Office”); and

WHEREAS, officials of the City of Lebanon and its residents have noted increased congestion in the parking of vehicles in front of the Post Office, which has a negative impact on traffic flow in the area and negatively impacts the business and properties located in the vicinity; and

WHEREAS, The Common Council for the City of Lebanon (“Council”) believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Lebanon to amend the Lebanon City Code to provide for time limitations on the parking of motor vehicles in front of the Post Office during its hours of operation; and

WHEREAS, The Council hereby finds it is in the public interest to amend Chapter 16, Article III, Section 16-34 (c) of the Lebanon City Code such that motor vehicle parking is heretofore restricted as follows:

No motor vehicle shall be parked in excess of ten (10) minutes between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Saturday on the north side of West Main Street between North West Street and the alley on the west side of the U.S. Post Office having an address of 304 West Main Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana that:


The Lebanon City Code is hereby amended to restrict the parking of motor vehicles on the north side of West Main Street between North West Street and the alley on the west side of the U.S. Post Office having an address of 304 W. Main Street, by inserting the following language in Chapter 16, Article III, Section 16-34 (c):

(17) No motor vehicle shall be parked in excess of ten (10) minutes between the hours of 8:00


a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Saturday on the north side of West Main Street between North West Street and the alley on the west side of the U.S. Post Office having an address of 304 West Main Street.

Passed and adopted this 9 day of AUGUST, 2010.


