

ORDINANCE NO. 2011- 16

**ESTABLISHMENT OF A RESERVE POLICE OFFICER PROGRAM FOR THE
LEBANON POLICE DEPARTMENT
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Indiana law provides for the City of Lebanon establish a Police reserve officer program pursuant to I.C. 36-8-3-20; and

WHEREAS, The Lebanon Board of Works administers the Lebanon Police Department ("Police Department") as codified in I.C. 36-8-3, and appoints officers to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Police Department has promulgated rules and regulations for the administration of a reserve officer program for the Police Department which includes the conduct of appointed reserve officers; and

WHEREAS, The Council for the City of Lebanon believes it is in the best interests of the public safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Lebanon to establish a reserve police officer program for the Police Department with the total number of officers in the program not to exceed ten (10).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA,**

1. The Chief of the Lebanon Police Department ("Chief"), at his discretion, may implement a police officer reserve program for the Lebanon Police Department ("Police Department"), pursuant to Indiana Code 36-8-3-20.
2. The number of reserve officers shall not exceed ten (10).
3. Appointments to the reserve officer program shall take place in the same manner as appointments of regular members of the Police Department.
4. Reserve officers shall have all the power and authority of regular members of the Police Department, except as restricted by the rules and regulations of the Police Department.
5. At the discretion of the Chief, and with the concurrence of the Board of Works, and to the extent that money is appropriated, the reserve officer may receive the following:
 - (a) A uniform allowance.
 - (b) Compensation for the time lost from other employment due to required appearances in court.
6. Reserve officers are not eligible to participate in any pension program provided for regular members of the Police Department.
7. A reserve officer may not be appointed until completion of the required training and probationary period mandated by the rules of the Police Department and Indiana Law.
8. A reserve officer may not:


- (a) Make an arrest;
- (b) Conduct a search or seizure of a person or property; or
- (c) Carry a firearm;

Unless the reserve officer successfully completes a course under I.C.5-2-1-9(f).

- 9. A reserve officer may be covered by medical treatment and burial expense provisions of the worker's compensation law (I.C. 22-3-2 through I.C. 22-3-6) and worker's occupational diseases law (I.C. 22-3-7). If compensability of the injury is an issue, the administrative procedures of I.C. 22-3-2 through I.C. 22-3-6 and I.C. 22-3-7 shall be used to determine the issue.






