

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-12

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEBANON COMMON COUNCIL
ESTABLISHING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR PURPOSES OF TRAINING
FOR THE LEBANON FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, may, pursuant to Indiana law [IC 36-1-3 (Home Rule)], enact ordinances for the effective governance of its departments; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Lebanon seeks to establish a non-reverting training fund for the Lebanon Fire Department ("LFD") such that it may collect funds from various entities and host training seminars, classes, exercises and activities for the advancement and betterment of LFD and the participating agencies; and

WHEREAS, the non-reverting fund shall be designated as the "LFD Non-Reverting Training Fund" ("Fund") and

WHEREAS, the LFD and the City shall deposit in the Fund monies and items of value received from participating agencies, including donations, fees, reimbursements and program costs to be held and expended for the costs and expenses of hosting training seminars, classes, exercises and activities for the advancement and training of participating agencies and their members, and such funds shall not revert to the City general account or other account at the end of each year, but shall be held over for further training from year to year.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AND ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is established a non-reverting training fund to be utilized by the City of Lebanon Fire Department ("LFD") to be designated as the "LFD Non-Reverting training Fund" ("Fund"). The City and LFD may deposit in the Fund such funds or monies received from participating agencies and use those deposits for the hosting of training seminars, classes, exercises and activities for the advancement and training of its members and those of participating agencies and their members.
2. The Fund may receive and deposit such fees, donations, costs and funds received from any participating agency or other organization if such funds are intended for the training and advancement of LFD and/or participating agencies, and the funds shall not revert to the City general fund, but shall be maintained in the Fund from year to year.
3. The funds captured may only be used for the purposes of hosting, sponsoring and conducting a training class. This includes payment for the instructor of the class, class materials, books, equipment, refreshments, printing cost, any expense or cost reasonably associated with training or class.


4. Claims may be made from this Fund by the Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief of the City of Lebanon Fire Department.
5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
6. This Ordinance shall repeal and replace any inconsistent or conflicting provision of previous ordinances.
